- 4 It is a healthy thing to grieve and not forget our loss. Note- There is a balance in grieving and not forgetting. Many grieve in an unhealthy manner that is not helpful at all. At the same time some do not forget in a way that can be detrimental to moving forward. (If you feel you are stuck because of a loss you need to seek some Biblical counsel.
- 5 Healthy grieving and remembering the past is what develops our “testimony”. Write down a testimony of how God has brought you through a difficult time. Next plan on sharing that testimony with someone else.
