DISCUSSION IGNITERS

- I Corinthians 15:12-20 Paul is speaking about how important the resurrection of Jesus is. What are your thoughts and beliefs about the Resurrection of Jesus?
- The story of Lazarus in **John 11** gives us some great understanding concerning our resurrection. Take some time to read the whole story.
- One of the fill-ins in the notes stated that Jesus would never lead us to death but He would lead us through death. See also Psalms 23:4. Why would we need to go through death?
- What awaits a follower of Jesus on the other side of death?
- Are you willing to allow some things in your life to die so that Jesus can bring something new?
- 6 Name some specific aspects of your life that you would like to see die. i.e. habits, thoughts, attitudes, actions
- While many people try to change some of these foundational flaws in our lives, who do you feel is the only one that can truly bring new life in those areas? Do you have a testimony of that happening?
- Before Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead there was a moment where he was angry? What or who was He angry at? Why?
- Jesus is all about wanting every person to experience resurrection. What is the promise in **Revelation 3:20**? Jesus did His part, what are you going to do?
