**Esther 2:5-7** <sup>(NLT)</sup> *“At that time there was a Jewish man in the fortress of Susa whose name was Mordecai son of Jair. He was from the tribe of Benjamin and was a descendant of Kish and Shimei. 6 His family had been among those who, with King Jehoiachin of Judah, had been exiled from Jerusalem to Babylon by King Nebuchadnezzar. 7 This man had a very beautiful and lovely young cousin, Hadassah, who was also called Esther. When her father and mother died, Mordecai adopted her into his family and raised her as his own daughter.”*

Who knows if perhaps you were made queen for just such a time as this?”*

## DISCUSSION IGNITERS

- 1 We learn 4 primary lessons from Mordecai. The first one is to take care of others. How did Mordecai demonstrate that in his life? What are some of the ways we can help take care of others?
- 2 Is there a Biblical principle in this lesson? What are some other Biblical examples of people taking care of others?
- 3 The second lesson seems so simple, but it is an important one. Do what is right. We all understand this, so why is it so difficult to do at times? What are some areas that you may have struggled in doing the right thing?
- 4 Reflect on **Galatians 6:9**. Talk about the implications of this verse.
- 5 The third lesson from Mordecai is to put God first in all things. What are some areas of our life that have a way of sneaking themselves up the ladder of importance?
- 6 What are some ways you have been able to keep God first in your life?
- 7 The fourth lesson is to not hide when we suffer. It's true that some will open up about every little thing wrong in their life. Nevertheless, there are many that suffer in silence. Why is that?
- 8 How can keeping your pain to yourself unhealthy for you and even others?
- 9 **Galatians 6:2** *"Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ."* Take a few minutes to discuss this verse and what that would look like in a local church that actually did this on a regular basis.
