DISCUSSION IGNITERS

- We learn 4 primary lessons from Mordecai. The first one is to take care of others. How did Mordecai demonstrate that in his life? What are some of the ways we can help take care of others?
- Is there a Biblical principle in this lesson? What are some other Biblical examples of people taking care of others?
- The second lesson seems so simple, but it is an important one. Do what is right. We all understand this, so why is it so difficult to do at times? What are some areas that you may have struggled in doing the right thing?
- 4 Reflect on Galatians 6:9. Talk about the implications of this verse.
- The third lesson from Mordecai is to put God first in all things. What are some areas of our life that have a way of sneaking themselves up the ladder of importance?
- 6 What are some ways you have been able to keep God first in your life?
- The fourth lesson is to not hide when we suffer. It's true that some will open up about every little thing wrong in their life.

 Nevertheless, there are many that suffer in silence. Why is that?
- 8 How can keeping your pain to yourself unhealthy for you and even others?
- 9 Galatians 6:2 "Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ." Take a few minuets to discuss this verse and what that would look like in a local church that actually did this on a regular basis.
