Psalms 119:105 “Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light for my path.”

2. THE BIBLE IS LIKE _____

Psalms 119:103 How sweet are your words to my taste, sweeter than honey to my mouth!

3. THE BIBLE IS A _____

II Timothy 3:16-17 All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, 17 so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.

4. THE BIBLE IS LIKE A _____

I Thessalonians 2:13 “And we also thank God continually because, when you received the word of God, which you heard from us, you accepted it not as the word of men, but as it actually is, the word of God, which is at work in you who believe

5. THE BIBLE IS A _____

Psalms 119:11 “I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you”

6. THE BIBLE IS A _____

Hebrews 4:12-13 “For the word of God is living and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart. 13 Nothing in all creation is hidden from God’s sight. Everything is uncovered and laid bare before the eyes of him to whom we must give account.
