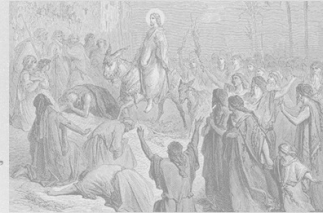

HIS TRIUMPHAL ENTRY

As they approached Jerusalem and came to the Mount of Olives, Jesus said to his disciples, "Go to the village in front of you and you will find a donkey tied there, with a colt beside it. Untie them and bring them to me. If anyone says anything to you, say that you need them, and he will send them." This took place to fulfill what was spoken through the prophet: Say to Daughter Zion, "See, your king comes to you, gentle and riding a donkey, the foal of a donkey." The disciples went and did as Jesus instructed. They brought the donkey and the colt and placed their cloaks on them for Jesus to sit on. Many spread their cloaks on the road, while others cut branches from the trees and spread them on the road. The crowds that went ahead of him and those that followed shouted, "Hosanna to the Son of David!" "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord." "The Son of David who reigns in glory." When Jesus entered Jerusalem, the whole city was stirred and asked, "Who is this?" The crowds answered, "This is Jesus, the prophet from Nazareth in Galilee." Jesus entered the temple courts and drove out all who were buying and selling there, and he overturned the tables of the money changers and the benches of those selling doves. "Here my house will be called a house of prayer," but you are making it a den of robbers." The blind and lame came to him at the temple, and he healed them. But when the chief priests and the teachers of the law saw the wonderful things he did and the children shouting in the temple courts, "Hosanna to the Son of David," they were indignant. "Do you hear what these children are saying?" they asked him. "Yes, Lord, but here he says, 'My house will be called a house of prayer for all nations.' You have made it a den of robbers."

John 12:1-3, 9 *“Six days before the Passover, Jesus arrived at Bethany, where Lazarus lived, whom Jesus had raised from the dead. 2 “Here a dinner was given in Jesus’ honor. Martha served, while Lazarus was among those reclining at the table with him. 3 Then Mary took about a pint of pure nard, an expensive perfume; she poured it on Jesus’ feet and wiped his feet with her hair. And the house was filled with the fragrance of the perfume.”*

3 LIVE OUT YOUR _____

Ephesians 2:4-6 *“But God is so rich in mercy, and he loved us so much, 5 that even though we were dead because of our sins, he gave us life when he raised Christ from the dead. (It is only by God’s grace that you have been saved!) 6 For he raised us from the dead along with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms because we are united with Christ Jesus.*

- 1** What were the events in the life of Jesus that preceded Palm Sunday? Why is this important?
- 2** Read Ephesians 2:10 “For we are God’s workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.” What does that mean to you?
- 3** Do you believe that you have a God-given mission? Why or why not? If yes, how are you going about fulfilling that mission?
- 4** What do we mean when we say “God is moving”?
- 5** How has God been moving in your life? What has been happening or what has God been teaching you?
- 6** Mary, Martha and Lazarus made Jesus welcome in their home by serving a meal and Mary anointed His feet. These can be seen as symbolic for the things we need to do to welcome the Holy Spirit to move in our lives. What are some specific ways you welcome the active presence of the Holy Spirit into your life daily?
- 7** The last point was to “Live out your testimony”. What does that look like to you?
- 8** Who will you try and bring close to Jesus this week?
