Mark 10:29-30 *"Then Peter began to speak up. 'We've given up everything to follow you.' 'Yes,' Jesus replied, 'and I assure you that everyone who has given up house or brothers or sisters or mother or father or children or property, for my sake and for the Good News, will receive now in return a hundred times as many houses, brothers, sisters, mothers, children, and property—along with persecution. And in the world to come that person will have eternal life.'"*

- 1 Think of historical figures who have had a major impact on our world. Who are they, and what difference did they make?
(e.g., George Washington, Abraham Lincoln, Martin Luther, etc.)
- 2 Consider the sacrifices made by the individuals mentioned above. What did their contributions cost them personally?
- 3 Why do you think sacrifice is required in order to make a difference in our world and in the Kingdom of God?
- 4 **Mark 8:34** *“Then he called the crowd to him along with his disciples and said: ‘If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross and follow me.’”* Have you ever had to give something up to follow Jesus? If so, what was it?
- 5 Life moves quickly, and if we’re not intentional, we may miss opportunities to sacrifice and positively impact others. What are some practical ways to slow down and recognize these moments?
- 6 Since you have become a follower of Jesus, have you ever had people question and possibly deter you from living a sacrificial life to God? How did you handle it?
- 7 Every time you sacrifice something for the Lord, it’s like planting a seed. What does this analogy mean, and what can you expect from that seed over time?
- 8 As you continue serving God, you begin to see the results of your sacrifices. What are some ways you’ve seen the “harvest” of your sacrifices?
- 9 Do you feel that God is calling you to surrender something, but you’ve been hesitant or unwilling? What is holding you back?
