DISCUSSION IGNITERS

- What's something in your life right now that feels like a "race" something you're striving toward or trying to finish well?
- Paul compares faith to a race where only one wins the prize. What does "running to win" look like in your spiritual life right now?

 Read 1 Corinthians 9:24–25.
- Everyone has a "finish line" they're chasing career, comfort, reputation, or faith. What finish line do you think you've been running toward lately? Has it been worth it?
- Jesus said to "take up your cross daily." What does daily surrender look like for you in practical terms?
- How do you recognize when God is speaking to you? What distractions make it harder for you to hear His voice clearly?
- What difference does it make when you invite the Holy Spirit to fill and guide you daily? Can you share a time when you sensed God's strength or peace beyond your own ability?
- "God has put you where He put you your job, family, and community are your assignments." How does that idea reshape the way you view your daily routine or relationships?
- We ended with the story of Edward Kimball one faithful man whose obedience reached generations. Who is someone you can influence this week even in a small way that could have an eternal impact?
