

DISCUSSION IGNITERS

- How would you describe the difference between "happiness" and "joy"? Why do you think joy is better?
- Luke 2:10 says, "...good news of great joy that will be for all the people." In your own words, how would you explain what the "good news" is, and why it brings great joy for all people?
- For many people, it is easy to always find something to complain about. How can a complaining or grumbling attitude hinder someone from experiencing the "great joy" we are promised?
- What attitude needs to replace a grumbling or complaining attitude?
- How does living a distracted life cause someone to miss the joy God wants for them? What is the solution to not living distracted?
- Christmas is about who? Joy comes when we learn to celebrate and place our focus on Jesus rather than ourselves. How can you teach this truth to your family, friends, children, or grandchildren?
- Do you think there is more to experience with God than what you already have? What are you going to do about it?
